

Reading between the lines, it means that Bell & Howell Co. has established quality control standards to produce the finest precision equipment that you can sell with complete confidence and that new and better packaging is being used to help assure us that our products reach your store in the same fine condition they leave our factory

Second: If, in spite of these measures, should you receive a piece of defective new merchandise, Bell & Howell Co. takes full responsibility and will assume all expenses involved in getting a properly-functioning replacement item to you as quickly as possible.

3 STEPS TO HAVING DEFECTIVE MERCHANDISE REPLACED

- 1 Repack defective item in its original carton and ship it "PREPAID" to the closest Bell & Howell Co. warehouse serving your area. (See Price Catalog, Page IV)
- 2. When product is received at warehouse, it will immediately be carefully inspected to verify the defect.
- 3. A new, replacement item will then be shipped to you, along with postage stamps which you can use to cover the shipping expenses you incurred.

Note If new replacement equipment is not readily available, defective product will immediately be repaired and returned to avoid unnecessary delays.

WHAT NOT TO DO:

Please do not return shopworn or abused products for replacement. Nor should you return merchandise that has missing parts, such as lenses, remote control units, reels, lamps, cords, etc.

In such an event, it will be necessary for us to repair the merchandise, we will return it to the dealer, and bill him the service charges that ordinarily apply







INTRODUCTION TO CANON FL AND R LENSES

Canon has manufactured three main types of lenses in recent years; Canon Lenses, Canon R Lenses, and Canon FL Lenses.

CANON LENSES: Lenses designated Canon have a Leica-thread screw mount and will fit Canon rangefinder-type cameras, most Leica screw-mount cameras, and similar types. These lenses couple to the rangefinder systems on Canon and most Leica cameras.

CANON R LENSES: Lenses designated Canon R have a breech-lock mount and a two-pin automatic diaphragm operation (except the Long Telephoto Lenses which have manua lens openings) Canon R lenses fit early single-lens reflex models, including the Canonflex R, RP, RM, and R-2000. These lenses sometimes carry the designations Super Canomatic or Canomatic. While Canon R lenses can be used with the FP, FX, TL-QL, FT-QL, Pellix, and Pellix QL cameras, their automatic diaphragm systems will not couple and the lens openings must be set manually

CANON FL LENSES: Lenses designated Canon FL have the same breech-lock mount as Canon R lenses, but are ighter in weight and have a simplified one-pin automatic diaphragm mechanism. Canon FL lenses are normally designated for use on the Canon FP FX, TL-QL, FT-QL, Pellix, and Pellix QL cameras, and on those accessories designated FL. They will work on any older model Canon reflex camera, but will not have automatic diaphragm operation. All Canon FL lenses have automatic diaphragms, depth-of-field scales, and manual aperture overrides for depth-of-field previewing (unless otherwise noted).

LONG TELEPHOTO LENSES: These lenses are designed for use on breech-lock mount cameras, but they do not have an automatic diaphragm mechanism. They contain a single control ring which is a manual aperture control. The lens itself does not contain a focusing collar as focusing and mounting is accomplished by using a Bellows R and Lens Supporter (see page 22). Filters (48mm special extra-thin) are inserted behind the lens in a carriage in the Lens Supporter The interchangeability of the Bellows R, Lens Supporter and filters between the various Long Telephoto Lenses means that only one set of these items is necessary for use with any of these lenses.

INTRODUCTION TO CLOSE-UP ACCESSORIES

The Canon System includes a complete line of accessories for all types of close-up photography including photomacrography and photomicrography To determine which accessory or group of accessories will best perform for a required job, follow these steps: 1) Ascertain accurately the size of the object to be photographed, 2) refer to the Usage Chart on the next page to see which combinations can be used, and 3) choose the accessory or combination of accessories which best suits your needs.

CLOSE-UP LENSES

Canon close-up lenses provide an easy and economical way to photograph objects as large as $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{4}$ " down to objects as small as $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3" (with normal lens). They are designed to thread into the filter threads of normal focal length lenses. Since no extension of the lens from the camera body is involved, no exposure correction is necessary. Close-up lenses come in two strengths; 450 or +2 diopter and 240 or +4 diopter The sizes available are 48mm and 58mm. The 450 close-up lens has a focusing range from the film plane of approximately 22" to 13" while the range of the 240 lens is approximately 13" to 10" Refer to the chart at the right for the proper lens type to photograph a given subject.

MACRO LENS

The Canon FL 50mm f/3.5 Macro Lens is designed to provide continuous focusing from infinity (∞) to 9.2" (from the film plane), and to 8.2" with the Life Size Adapter The lens alone will photograph objects as small as 2" x 2%" with the object filling the frame. With the Life Size Adapter attached to the lens, objects can be photographed so that the image size on the negative or slide is exactly the same size as the object (1:1 photography). The focusing collar of the lens provides 25mm extension, and the Life Size Adapter an additional 25mm extension. This total of 50mm extension makes 1:1 photography possible.

Exposure compensation for the extension due to close focusing is automatic for lens alone or with the adapter As the lens is focused out for a subject at a close distance, the lens aperture automatically opens wider to compensate for the extension. The automatic diaphragm mechanism is automatic with or without the adapter installed. Separate scales for magnification and distance are provided for the lens alone or with the adapter.

EXTENSION TUBES AND RINGS

Canon manufactures two types of extension rings and tubes, those with the FL designation, and those without. The FL tubes and rings have breech-lock mounts for use directly with FL lenses and breech-mount camera bodies. The 15mm and 25mm Extension Tubes FL have mechanisms which retain the automatic diaphragm feature of FL lenses. The tubes and rings without FL designations have Leica-type screw thread mounts on each end. To use them with breech-lock mount camera bodies and FL lenses, Lens Mount Converters A and B are needed. Converter A has an effective thickness of 2.8mm, while Converter B has a thickness of 13.2mm. Combined, as when used with rings or tubes, they will add up to an additional 16mm extension over that of the ring or tube itself.

MACRO PHOTO COUPLERS

Macro Photo Couplers are used for reversing lenses in order to obtain the flattest field possible. They thread into the filter threads of the lens. When a lens is reversed on a camera body or on tubes, the focusing part of the lens is ineffective as the lens is mounted by its front ring. Macro Photo Couplers FL have a built-in focusing feature and a breech-lock mount. The standard Macro Photo Couplers (not designated FL) are non-focusing and have a Leica-type thread mount, therefore they must be used with a Converter A and an extension ring on breech-lock mount cameras or tubes.


BELLOWS

Especially designed for photomacrography, bellows are used to extend the lens away from the camera body with a variable amount of extension. They perform the same function as extension tubes but are more convenient and easy to use. The Bellows FL has a semi-automatic lens diaphragm actuating mechanism for use with FL lenses. This bellows also has three moving stages with lens extension and magnification scales. The Bellows R is designed primarily as the focusing system for Long Telephoto Lenses (see page 22), but by adding the Bellows R Adapter Ring, regular FL or R lenses can be used with it for photomacrography. Lenses used on the Bellows R must have the lens diaphragms set manually.

MISCELLANEOUS

Many other accessories are available for close-up photography. These include the Photomicrographic Hood and Photomicro Unit F which are used for coupling a breech-lock mount camera body (or bellows) to a microscope. ^{*}EXPOSURE FACTOR: When a lens is extended away from the camera body with extension tubes, rings, or bellows more light is required for a proper exposure. This is known as exposure factor. It may be computed by the following formula: EX = (I + M)², where EX is exposure factor and M is the magnification ratio expressed as a fraction. For example, with 50mm extension on a normal lens the factor is 4X. This means 4 times as much light is needed. Therefore, you would open the lens 2 F/stops, or divide the shutter speed by 4. Exposure factor is automatically compensated for with the Macro Lens; and is not necessary when using cameras with through-the-lens meters. (Pellix QL, Pellix, TL, and FT.)







The following is intended as a guide to Bell & Howell policies and procedures to insure equitable and considerate adjustment of your customer's service needs.

Their use and understanding in practice will generate consumer-dealer good will as well as minimize commitments that might cause unintended expense.

APPLICATION AND INTERPRETATION OF BELL & HOWELL GUARANTEE

The Bell & Howell guarantee stated in the catalog introduction section accompanies each of our products. Dealer sales and service personnel should understand it thoroughly to insure proper interpretation.

The intent of the product guarantee is to assure the purchaser of our equipment that Bell & Howell has exercised care in instituting methods of control in fabricating and assembly processes to produce a quality product whose performance measures up to specifica-

tions. If for any reason malfunction should occur within 1 year from its purchase, attributable to a defect in materials (whether latent or not), or because of inadequacies in assembling the product, Bell & Howell will undertake, without cost to dealer or consumer (except transportation), the adjustment of the product. This guarantee does not cover the replacement of film or magnetic tape damaged through the malfunction of the product and warrants lamp replacement only as explained below.

IMPLIED SITUATIONS COVERED BY BELL & HOWELL GUARANTEE

Beyond the immediate warranty period, Bell & Howell considers it an obligation to maintain adequate inventory of parts that will provide consumers with maintenance of their Bell & Howell equipment for many years to come.

Implied is also the conditional promise that design features of components incorporated on new models may be made available on existing models of a similar type, provided such modifications are practical in terms of the economic and technical factors involved. Bell & Howell will officially announce and offer them as a service modification. Until such announcement, no modification will be made. In many instances, the latest technical changes are incorporated into products as they are serviced without extra charge and without specific mention.

BELL & HOWELL/CANON PRODUCT SERVICE

It is understood that Bell & Howell will provide servicing on all Canon model cameras. Canon product that requires service whether "In or Out" of warranty may be returned, transportation prepaid, directly to Bell & Howell Company, Chicago, or its branch service departments in Glendale, California and Farmingdale, L.I., New York, or to a designated franchised approved Field Service Station. Bell & Howell will administer the warranty service under the terms and conditions specified by the Canon Camera Company

In order to process this repair properly under the terms of the warranty, it is essential that we have the warranty card originally issued with this equipment. If this is not available, please advise us of the date and country in which the equipment was sold.

1. Warranty Service on Canon or Bell & Howell/ Canon cameras and accessories purchased in the United States is performed free of charge.

- Warranty service on Canon cameras and accessories purchased outside the United States is provided free of charge under warranty only in Japan, in country of purchase, and in direct Canon service stations in Geneva, Switzerland and Panama City
- Warranty service on Canon cameras and accessories purchased outside the United States is provided at our costs of labor, material, handling, packaging and transportation.

There is no obligation on the part of the manufacturer or we, Bell & Howell Company, as administrator and service agent, for assuming liability or consequential loss of any kind in conjunction with the use of Canon product, or accepting for credit or replacement, equipment sold by other Canon product distributors.

NOTES ON EQUIPMENT RETURNED FOR REPAIRS

When equipment is returned for repair, we assume the customer expects to get back a product which is in perfect mechanical working order. For this reason, we check the entire unit. At times we receive equipment with instructions to repair a specific item, but upon examination find that it requires complete tear-down in order to repair some internal part. We may also find other adjustments are required. In such cases, we make the additional repairs where the cost is minor and falls within our (b), or (c) classification.

If repair expense is considerable, and cannot properly be classified under our established rates, we will submit a quotation before work is begun. The customer may then decide whether or not he wishes the suggested repair If specific repair and no other is wanted by customer, even though in our judgment additional work is needed to place equipment in good working order, our responsibility will be limited to only such specified repair

If a specified repair is not practical or advisable without making additional essential repairs suggested by us under our regular repair classifications, we reservice the right to return equipment without undertaking any work on same.

EXTENSIVE RE-BUILDING:

Extensive re-building to correct effects of damage from external sources (such as water, dropping, fire, unusual climatic conditions, etc.) will be quoted on a time-and-material basis. We will submit a quotation for your approval before proceeding with the work.

ADAPTATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS:

Equipment must be in good mechanical operating condition before any adaptations or modifications can be made. Charges for repairs required to bring equipment up to standard operating order will be *in addition* to those listed for making adaptations or modifications. When a camera is to be adapted or modified for a turret

installation, we recommend that lenses be returned with the equipment to assure proper fitting of lenses to the turret; this will also enable us to orient the lens index markings in the most convenient position on the turret. (See "LENS REPAIRS")

LENS REPAIRS:

Lenses other than Bell & Howell, Bell & Howell-Angenieux, or Canon, can not be accepted for repairs. Occasionally, due to extensive damage, it may be necessary to send a Bell & Howell-Angenieux lens to France; consequently, this procedure would require an extended period of time. Should this be necessary, we will notify Dealer

Replacement of lens elements, or re-cementing, or

repairs on damaged lens mounts, will be handled on a time and material basis. If specifically requested, a quotation will first be furnished.

For general cleaning and checking of a lens, the established rate shown in price book will apply Cleaning and checking of one (1) lens accompanying each camera is included under regular repair classifications for the camera involved.

DISCONTINUED DESIGNS:

Models which have been out of production for ten years or more will be repaired provided such repair parts are still available.

PACKING EQUIPMENT FOR SHIPMENT:

Shipments should be packed to withstand the hazards of transport. Often, heavier pieces of equipment are not adequately packed by dealers. Whenever possible, use the original shipping carton with the inserts. If original carton is not available, place equipment in a container large enough to allow plenty of space for packing material.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF EQUIPMENT RECEIPT:

We will mail you an acknowledgement advising you we have received your unit for repair The service record number, model number, and serial number will be shown on this acknowledgement. Please mention this information when corresponding with us regarding the repair.

SERVICE TIME:

In most cases, repaired equipment will be ready for return shipment within seven days after arrival. Occasional heavy work loads may make it impossible for us to maintain this schedule on some types of equipment. Equipment sent in for special work will necessarily take longer—some modifications as much as 3 to 4 weeks if machining operations are required. Remember to allow for transit time to and from your location. Packaging, handling, insurance, and shipping costs will be added to the repair charges.

INSTRUCTIONS-WHAT'S WRONG:

- 1. Poor results are quite often due to improper use of the equipment. We suggest reference to the instruction book to make certain the customer understands the proper use of the equipment. If there is a malfunction, give a written description of the problem and enclose this information with the equipment. Also include the date the equipment was purchased and the dealer and owner names and addresses. If previously repaired, give the place and date of last service. If an estimate is required, please specify
- 2. On rush repair, specify the date you must have. Order will be given special handling and every possible effort made to meet your delivery schedule.
- Equipment will be returned best possible way recognizing probable speed of delivery, cost and handling care.
- 4. Requests for "in-warranty" service must state (a) date equipment was purchased, (b) where purchased, and (c) name and address of owner of equipment.

BEFORE REQUESTING ESTIMATE: READ THIS:

REMEMBER!! ESTIMATES CAUSE DELAY!! They require double correspondence, storage of equipment awaiting approval of estimate, rescheduling repair work in proper sequence from date of approved estimate.

In the interest of expediting service we believe you can provide a reasonably accurate estimate to the cus-

tomer at the time equipment is brought in to your store for repair

It is suggested that you use the Class "B" and Class "C" repair classifications as the minimum and maximum price range. Referring to the following guidelines will assist you in making this estimate.

DEFINITION OF REPAIR CHARGE CLASSIFICATIONS

Most of the equipment returned for repairs will be billed under the (B) or (C) repair classifications listed in this schedule. The extent of the work performed under each classification is described below This information is submitted for your guidance in determining the probable charge for repair Actual charge will be determined upon receipt and inspection of equipment.

Service charges are classified in three groups. In each case the class and charge will place the equipment in perfect operating order.

- CLASS A General Overhaul) Applies to considerably worn or old equipment requiring replacement of wear parts, plus all major film handling parts, motor repairs and sound repairs on projectors.
- CLASS B (Routine Repair) Applies to moderately worn equipment. Includes all work per-

formed in Class C, plus replacement of various wear parts, when required. Does not include complete rebuilding of film transports or similar precision assemblies which are included in Class A.

CLASS C (Preventative Maintenance) Covers disassembly of equipment, cleaning, reassembly, lubrication (where necessary), all required adjustments, plus inspection. This service not available when any parts are required that are not covered by Bell & Howell guarantee.

Note: Additional charges will be made for replacement of items such as tubes, lamps, batteries, speakers, motors, lenses, cords, amplifiers, cases, etc. Flat rate service does not apply to equipment which has been damaged, abused or altered.

APPLYING CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES

- CLASS C This classification will usually apply to most cameras and projectors that have been in use several years. The mechanism, electric eye and zoom lens systems are operational although user may report that end results are not satisfactory even though he has exercised care in following correct operational procedure.
- CLASS B This classification will usually apply when the camera or projector is more than several years old and is non or intermittently operational.
- CLASS A This classification will apply when the camera or projector is quite old, the mechanism sounds badly worn, or is non-operational in film transport, sound system, electric eye and zoom lens system. This generally indicates it requires complete rebuilding and also applies to equipment that is damaged through accident, corrosion, water, fire, etc. This category of repair accomplished on a time and material basis for which a request for estimate would be appropriate.

REPAIR CLASSIFICATION

All servicing is classified and billed according to the appropriate Flat Rate Schedule as listed under A B C categories.

When the correction of a specific functional system as shown in the Flat Rate Schedule enables satisfactory adjustment of the entire camera, it alone will apply In instances where combination of systems repair is required, each individual flat rate applies. Equipment that is serviced in accordance with our functional systems repair classification is warranted to be free of defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year from date of our service repair invoice.

In instances where only a specific repair adjustment is requested (designated as per customer instruction), we reserve the right to decline undertaking such partial repair or if accepted, our responsibility is limited to such specific adjustment.

Each unit serviced (except as per customer is subject to a complete visual, instrumented and operational test procedures in keeping with product performance specifications. Service repair warranty applies specifically to proper adjustment of the equipment. No lia-

bility expressed or implied is assumed for loss of film or any other expenses in connection with the use of the serviced product.

Bell & Howell Company will provide warranty service on Canon cameras and accessories purchased outside of the United States at our costs of labor, material, handling, packaging and transportation.

- Class A (Overhaul) Applies to equipment which has been exposed to extensive wear and tear, or damaged equipment requiring rebuilding of major assemblies.
- Class B (Routine repair) Applies to equipment which has been given normal care and has been subjected to normal usage. Includes replacement of any worn parts, cleaning, lubrication (where required) and adjustment
- Class C (Protective Maintenance) Applies to equipment which has been given normal care and usage. Includes cleaning, lubrication (where required) and adjustment. Includes only the replacement of minor parts such as screws, clips, etc.
