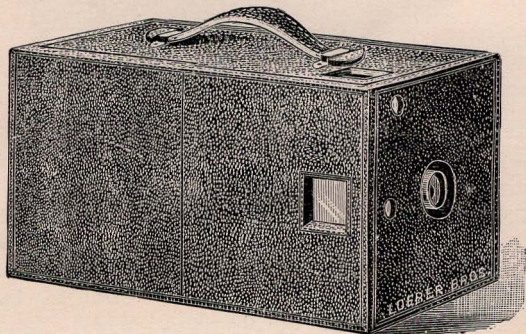

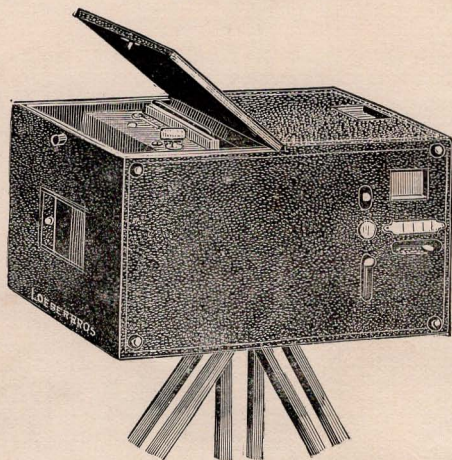

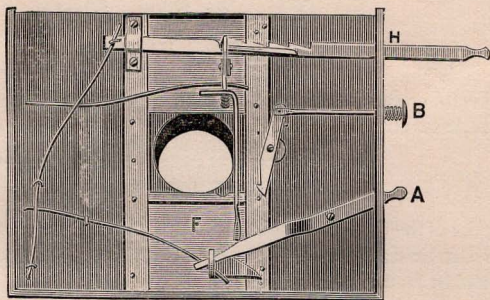
The focusing adjustment is set from the outside, and is accurate and reliable, or the focus may be made on the ground glass, which goes with each camera.

The Stops (3 in number) can be easily changed to allow for different intensity of light.

The Shutter which works back of the lens (in this respect it has a special advantage over all detective cameras,) can be adjusted for slow, and rapid instantaneous work, or used with open lens for time exposure.

The Shutter is a most ingenious device—simple, cannot get out of order and being entirely of metal, it will not swell and stick in damp weather.

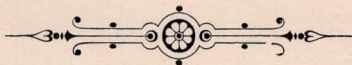

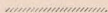
