SHIPPING POLICY

All merchandise is sold F.O.B. point of shipment. TRANSIT CLAIMS

We invite our authorized dealers to contact their nearest Olympus warehouse to ascertain the availability of Class II merchandise. Terms and conditions of sale will be explained when each order is placed. Orders for Class II Merchandise will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis and are subject to acceptance by Olympus.

OLYMPUS ADVERTISING REBATE SUPPORT PROGRAM

Local advertising and promotion is an extension of Olympus' national advertising program.

The Olympus advertising rebate program is designed to help you obtain more for your advertising dollars spent in support of Olympus products.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Local dealer advertising allowances are 3% of the net value of each qualifying order. Advertising allowances accrued by the dealer will be reflected in his monthly statement. Olympus will pay 100% of the actual space costs for general interest newspapers which qualify for second class mailing privileges and provide a rate card and circulation information verifiable through audit; or net time costs only (not production) of radio or TV commercials; or printing or distribution costs of general consumer catalogs; or printing cost only of stuffers, flyers, or regional and local magazines and inserts. Printed advertising matter and TV commercials must illustrate and describe Olympus products. Radio spots must devote 60% of content to Olympus products. The Olympus trademark must be prominently and adequately displayed in proportion to the total size of the print and TV advertising; and prominently presented in radio advertising.

BE CAREFUL TO:

- Honestly represent products and offers.
- Submit your claim with proof of performance, copy of the invoice and ANA/RAB Documentation for radio, and ANA/TVB Documentation for TV to: Olympus, c/o Advertising Checking Bureau, P.O. Box 1919, Memphis, Tenn. 39101
- Use advertising allowances as reflected on your monthly statement for advertising within 9 months of their issue date. Expired advertising credit will not be honored.
- Use advertising allowance accruals only for current Olympus products, or obtain written approval for other promotional Olympus products as may be designated.

BE CAREFUL NOT TO:

- Deduct any claims from your invoice payment.
- Advertise outside your local trading zone.
- Advertise a mixture of Olympus products with non-Olympus products, such as other manufacturers's lenses or strobes.
- Use advertising allowances for classified ads or ads in national magazines such as Popular Photography.
- Misrepresent products or offers.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

With prior approval in writing from the Olympus Advertising Department and proof of performance, advertising allowances may be used for: (a) rental and decoration of that portion of a booth used in regional consumer shows devoted to Olympus products, providing 60% of total claim is used to advertise the show in eligible media; (b) 50%, but no more than \$500, of the cost of designing, manufacturing, and installing, but not of maintaining, indoor signs advertising Olympus products; (c) other advertising or promotional media up to \$500. Only one claim will be processed for each ad. With prior written approval, add-on advertising allowance will be accepted at a later date for general catalogs.

GUIDELINES FOR GENERAL CONSUMER CATALOGS*

You'll need the following "Proof of Advertising" when submitting your claim:

- 1. A COMPLETE CATALOG.
- 2. A NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT, signed by an officer of your company, certifying the actual quantity produced and distributed and your printing and distribution costs. Payment will be made *Only* if the following documents accompany the affidavit: (a) PAID INVOICE(S) showing detailed, itemized printing and distribution costs; plus, (b) UNITED STATE POSTAL SERVICE MAILING RECEIPTS detailing the cost of the catalog distribution.
- 3. ADVERTISING REBATE CREDITS, sufficient to cover the claim made.

GUIDELINES FOR STUFFERS, FLYERS, MAILING PIECES*

You'll need the following "Proof of Advertising" when submitting your claim:

- **1.** A **SAMPLE** of the completed printed piece.
- 2. A NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT, signed by an officer of your company, certifying the actual quantity produced and distributed. Payment will be made only if a PAID INVOICE FROM YOUR PRINTER detailing the itemized printing costs accompanies the affidavit, and you have accrued sufficient advertising allowance.
- 3. FOR MAILING PIECES ONLY, AN AFFIDAVIT indicating the number of pieces mailed and the area of distribution, along with postage receipts.
- **4.** ADVERTISING ALLOWANCES, sufficient to cover claim made.
- *All terms of the Advertising Allowance Program not superceded by the above remain in effect.

PRICE PROTECTION POLICY

If Olympus reduces the dealer net price on any product in this catalog, or in any offer made in a promotional mailing, during the effective term of this catalog or the promotional offer by more than \$1.00, then, subject to an inventory audit by Olympus, the dealer will be credited for the cost difference for any inventory purchased within the prior 90 days and remaining in stock.

Changes in terms, anticipation, or dating conditions do not qualify for price protection.

DISCONTINUED MERCHANDISE POLICY

When any Olympus products totaling more than \$5,000 are discontinued and sold to retail photographic dealers, Olympus will offer the merchandise by mail to all dealers or, if the quantity is not sufficient, to all dealers in a selected area.

All orders will be held for 15 days and then allocated to assure participating dealers of an equitable share of such product and price.

INVENTORY BALANCING

Between January 1 and February 28, 1978, dealers will be able to balance inventories of Olympus products in accordance with the Olympus dealer support program.

Between March 1, 1978, and June 25, 1978, dealers will be able to balance inventories as follows: up to 20% of prior 6 months purchases of Olympus products may be returned for balancing.

All returns are subject to the following condition:

Prior written approval by your Olympus salesman is required on an inventory balancing form. Only unopened, brand-new merchandise may be returned for inventory balancing. Close-outs or discontinued products are not eligible for inventory balancing. Credit for returned merchandise will be issued at the prices on the original invoice, unless the prices have been reduced by an inventory protection program. The new balancing order will be at the prices prevailing at the time of shipment. Returned merchandise must be shipped prepaid to your nearest Olympus distribution center.

Charges for this service are as follows: dollar to dollar balancing, 5%; one and a half dollars to one balancing, 2½%; two dollars to one balancing, 0.
