THE Ica Cameras described in the following pages of this abridged list represent only a rew of the models manufactured by this well known firm. As space however would not allow all models being listed those most popular have only been included.

The Ica Co., has been formed by the union of the camera works of R. Hüttig & Son, Emil Wünsche, Dr. R. Krügener, Zulauf & Co. and the camera department of Carl Zeiss, Jena. It is therefore not only the oldest, but the largest manufacturing company of its kind in Germany, and in fact, Europe.

The name Ica on any camera or on any article of photographic apparatus ensures to the purchaser the fact that nothing better of its kind can be obtained. The name itself stands as an assurance that the utmost reliance can be placed in the article which bears it, a most desirable feature when one considers what a lot depends on the instrument itself. The great aim of the Ica Co., is to produce an article of the highest possible quality.

All the cameras described herein are fitted for use with a tripod, the screw thread being of the American standard size.

Ica productions are manufactured in two large factories and in addition to Photographic cameras, accessories and sundries for photographers, include Projection apparatus, Enlarging Apparatus, Cinematographs for Theatres, Schools and the Home and all accessories pertaining to them.

Full particulars of any particular instrument will be gladly furnished on application.

LENSES

Ica cameras are equipped with the following lenses and are listed with camera number and letters indicating the actual lens fitted to the particular model and the actual shutter.

Thus "111 UCp" would be the Ica Ideal $3\frac{1}{2}$ x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. with Zeiss Tessar f/4.5 lens and Compur shutter.

The well known "Compur" shutter has been adopted as the standard between-lens shutter for the Ica cameras but the simpler models Nos. XI and X can also be fitted and can in most cases be supplied immediately if required.

For time, bulb or instantaneous exposures up to $\frac{1}{200}$ of a second in the smaller and up to $\frac{1}{250}$, $\frac{1}{200}$, $\frac{1}{150}$ and $\frac{1}{100}$ in the larger sizes.

"NOVAR" ANASTIGMAT F/6.8

(Angle about 70° with small stop)

Anastigmat consisting of three separated lenses, uncemented, with spheric, chromatic and astigmatic correction. Good covering power up to an angle of 58° at full aperture. Efficient for time and instantaneous work, landscapes, portraits, architecture, etc. The back combination cannot be used alone. Consequently the "Novar" lends itself to cameras with single extension.

C

"LITONAR" ANASTIGMAT F/6.8

(Angle 61° with a small stop)

Anastigmat consisting of four separated lenses, uncemented with spheric, achromatic and astigmatic correction. Good covering power up to an angle of 58° at full aperture. Efficient for time and instantaneous work, landscapes, portraits, architecture, etc. The back combination can be used with a small stop, as a good lens for landscapes, having about double the focal length of the entire doublet.

DOUBLE ANASTIGMAT "HEKLA" F/6.8

(Angle about 80° with a small stop)

Double anastigmat, consisting of four separated uncemented lenses, with spheric, chromatic and astigmatic correction. Good covering power up to an angle of 60° with full aperture, and excellent central definition.

Efficient for all normal time and instantaneous exposures, for landscapes, portraits, architecture, amplifications and reproductions.

Can be used advantageously as wide angle lens for photographing interiors, as long as the focal length is not smaller than the shortest side of the plate.

The back combination can be used with smaller stops as an excellent landscape lens of about double the focal length of the entire doublet.

ANASTIGMAT "DOMINAR" F/4.5

(Angle about 62° at a small stop)

A non symmetrical anastigmat, of which the front system consists of two separated lenses and the back combination of two cemented ones.

Excellent correction of the spheric and chromatic aberrations.

Good covering of an angle of 55° at full aperture, splendid brilliancy, central definition and excellent covering to the edges.

Astigmatism and coma are nearly completely eliminated. The back combination cannot be used independently, but in its stead we recommend for cameras with double extension the use of our "Delta" additional lenses, which, placed upon the Dominar, prolongates its focal length respectively.

This combination offers considerable advantages, when compared with the use of the back system of a symmetrical lens, as there are;—less distortion, better definition up to the edges, easier manipulation, etc.

It is fitted with a Brilliant view finder and spirit level which is reversible allowing either horizontal or vertical pictures to be made.

The camera has a double extension allowing the photographing of objects as close as 9 ins. to the camera. The rear element of lenses which are convertible i. e. Hekla can be used and the resulting image is about double that produced with the combined lens. Supplementary lenses can be supplied for use with the unconvertible type of lenses i. e. Zeiss Tessar and Ica Dominar.

Both rising and cross front are features of this admirable instrument and are invaluable where it is desired to use the camera for photographing architectural studies.

Focussing is accomplished by means of a rack and pinion and for critical work use should be made of the hooded focussing screen for viewing the object before making an exposure.

The outfit includes camera and three single metal slides and cable release.



The Trona is made of light metal, is leather covered and embodies the most perfect workmanship and design.



This camera is similar to No. 496. It is furnished with Compur Shutter and lenses E/R/H/G/T/U/Z. It is fitted with a brilliant reflecting finder. direct vision finder (Iconometer) and V shape front. Focussing is done by lever adjustment. It is also fitted with one tripod screw for horizontal pictures, besides a stand for vertical pictures. Furthermore there is a new arrangement for winding off the film. It is built into the back of the camera, and permits the film spool to be inserted, independently of the camera. The film runs underneath two little metal rollers which preserve the emulsion from being scratched.

The Icarette I by reason of the extreme simplicity of its working and its compactness has attained great popularity.

Focusing is accomplished by a lever adjustment and the method of loading the camera by removing the back is of the simplest nature.

Two finders, an "Iconometer" Direct vision finder and Brilliant view finder are provided and the camera is fitted with a cross front.

The size of the picture made with this camera lends itself particularly well to enlarging, as being square it may more easily be proportioned correctly.

Camera No. 496 is similar to No. 495 but with the addition of a plate back that allows plates 4.5 x 6 cm. to be used as an alternative to roll films.






