High performance with minimum equipment—specially suitable for wide-angle photography. 5 formats, from 6×6 to 4×5.

The camera «body» of the SINAR-handy is simply the format frame and 4×5 inch back of the SINAR-p. Add to it the hand grip and tripod adapter. Apart from the lenses (in focusing mounts), all other accessories are drawn from the SINAR system. That makes the SINAR-handy particularly good value. The SINAR-handy is simple in equipment terms and handling. If you can use a miniature camera, you will be at home with the SINAR-handy.




Extending the SINAR-handy

Despite the large picture size the SINAR-handy is a light-weight camera—it weighs just 4% lbs with 65 mm lens and hand grip. It is also compact—you can take it in a briefcase or a kit bag. The SINAR-handy covers five standard film sizes: $2\% \times 2\%$ inches $(6 \times 6 \text{ cm})$, $2\% \times 2^7/\text{s}$ inches $(56 \times 72 \text{ mm})$, $2\% \times 3\%$ inches $(6.5 \times 9 \text{ cm})$ and the main view camera formats of 4×5 inches and $9 \times 12 \text{ cm}$.

You have a professional choice of films and film holders: No. 120, 220 and 70 mm roll films, 4×5 inch and 9×12 cm sheet films with every type of emulsion, 4×5 inch film packs and 4×5 inch Polaroid instant picture materials (including retrievable negative film). The lens range covers six Super-Angulon lenses in focal lengths of 47, 65, 75, and 90 mm, all in focusing mounts.





As its name implies, the SINAR-handy is handy and convenient to hold upright or horizontally. With this mobility and its large and brilliant ground glass screen image you can also use it ideally with the Binocular Reflex Magnifier and Fresnel lens for best judgement of the perspective.







Binocular Reflex Magnifier

The SINAR Binocular Magnifier shows a brilliant, upright, and large ground glass screen image. It is particularly suitable for round-the-corner viewing and focusing, with high-angle and low-angle shots and in not easily accessible camera positions. Its exclusive adjustable mirror shows a brilliant screen image right into the corners. The built-in 21/2-times magnifier swings into view and out of the way without taking your eye off the screen. The hood completely screens off stray light and is ideal also for spectacle wearers.

Naturally you can also use the SINAR Binocular Magnifier with the SINAR universal square bellows for viewing and focusing.

For perfect viewing of the brilliant ground glass screen with the hand-held or tripod-mounted camera. The two-eyed view gives an ideal impression of the pictorial effect.
