

Compendium Sunshade




Original *Linhof* Compendium Sunshade

1 Adapter ring

3 Screw-in ring

2 Locking ring with filter holder

4 Sunshade tube



It is a well-known fact in photography that any direct light-rays hitting the lens cause reflexes or halation on the negative. Even side light may have a detrimental effect upon the brilliancy of the negative. Such inadequacies will be compensated for by the use of a sunshade.

In addition, the sunshade protects the sensitive lens from rain or other external influences. It is, therefore, always recommended to use a sunshade, especially when taking colour photographs. Some photographers have objections to use sunshades because of awkward handling when using them in combination with filters or simply because ordinary sunshades slip off the lens mount too easily.

Such inconvenience no longer exists since our new Compendium Sunshade insures a reliable grip on the lens mount. This is achieved by a locking device which is operated by two clamping heads. One of these is spring loaded and pressed together after the sunshade is slipped on the lens mount.

Filters are fastened in front of the lens by simply inserting them into the filter holder of the locking ring where a catch device automatically insures absolute parallelism of the faces and prevents the filters from slipping out. Each filter tab carries its

respective colour and density marking. This facilitates rapid filter change even with fixed sunshade.

The following filters are available:

yellow 0	green I	red I
I	green II	red II
II	UV (ultra violet)	orange
III		blue

Since slip-in filters are not common in some countries, provisions have been made to hold ordinary filters in place: The sunshade tube will be unscrewed and the filter inserted into the front of the locking ring, where it is secured either by the sunshade tube screwed on again or by a screw-in ring, delivered with the original LINHOF Compendium Sunshade.

Original LINHOF Compendium Sunshades are available in the following diameters:

Ø 70 mm	with adapter ring of Ø 60 mm
Ø 60 mm	" " " " Ø 51 mm
Ø 51 mm	" " " " Ø 42 mm

When inserting adapter rings which permit one original LINHOF Compendium sunshade to be used on two or more lenses of a different diameter within the combinations indicated above, care must be taken that the red dots are in an opposite position.



Cameras equipped with lenses of 42 mm diameter only do not call for a Compendium sunshade of 51 mm diameter with a 42 mm adapter ring because we have available a separate, very handy all-metal Compendium sunshade of 42 mm diameter which has the same advantages as our new Original LINHOF Compendium Sunshade with adapter ring.
