GENERAL INFORMATION-

NOTICE

The possession of this Price List does not necessarily entitle the possessor to the net prices shown, nor is it necessarily an offer to sell. All prices are subject to change without notice. No adjustment will be made because of price changes.

IMPORTANT

The net prices shown in this Price List include 10% manufacturers Federal Excise Tax, except for those items marked to indicate that the tax will not be added. When invoicing, the tax will be shown as a separate figure computed on the total of net prices for items on which the Federal Excise Tax applies.

TERMS

The net prices contained in this Price List are available to our authorized direct accounts. Terms are 2% discount for payment received on or before the 10th of the month following date of invoice. All bills due net thereafter. There is no 2% discount on laboratory services, photofinishing envelopes, advertising materials and booklets. Prices do not include sales taxes imposed by Federal, State or City Government or subdivisions thereof.

SMALL ORDERS—A "handling charge" of 50 cents will be assessed for all orders for photographic merchandise (not including backorders, laboratory service charges, advertising items, etc.) totalling less than \$10.00 at net billing prices. This amount will be added to the invoice in each case.

BASIC NET PRICE SCHEDULE AND QUANTITY DISCOUNTS

BLACK-AND-WHITE FILM

It is no longer necessary to purchase a \$70.00 minimum of black-and-white roll and 35mm miniature camera films to gain the additional 5% discount as heretofore. New net prices for roll and 35mm films shown on page 6 reflect the full discount in any quantity purchased.

CAMERAS AND ACCESSORIES

A1 Schedule: This schedule reflects additional discounts which may be earned on certain cameras and accessories by ordering in carton lots (or in the case of certain indicated cameras, in assortments of three). These additional discounts may be earned on certain camera cases by purchasing them with their respective cameras.

A2 Schedule: Basic net prices.

HOW TO USE PRICE CODE:

Net prices in this price schedule appear in the column immediately preceding the List Price column and are shown as follows: 29824-77. This is read by eliminating the first three fictitious digits (29824-77) and substituting a decimal point for the hyphen (\$24.77). Note that net prices for roll and 35mm miniature camera films are rounded off to three decimal places. Camera repair prices shown on page 22 are subject to 25% trade discount and are not coded.

RETURN GOODS POLICY-

OUTDATED SENSITIZED MATERIAL

- Credit of 25% of the List Price (without tax) will be allowed when outdated material is returned—Federal Excise Tax will also be credited on the net amount where applicable. (Indirect dealers may return outdated material for exchange. Replacement on the same 25% basis will be made in 620 All-Weather Pan roll film.)
- Materials must be returned directly to Ansco, Binghamton, New York, attention Returned Goods Department, transportation charges fully prepaid.
- 3. No credit will be allowed on the return of unlisted sizes or special products.

SENSITIZED MATERIALS NOT YET EXPIRED AND NON-SENSITIZED MATERIAL

- 1. Full credit or replacement will be made for material found to be defective in manufacture, labeling or packaging, but such material should be returned only after receiving written approval from a customer's regular Ansco District Sales Office.
- 2. Errors in ordering that might result in an overstock should be reported to a customer's regular Ansco District Sales

Office WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF RECEIPT OF MATERIAL. If possible, we will authorize return without loss, but no material of this kind will be accepted without our written permission. In no case will such credits be authorized for the following:

- Packages bearing labels or markings not affixed by Ansco.
- b. Unlisted sizes or units.
- c. Special products or coatings in any size or unit.
- Errors in shipment must be reported to a customer's regular Ansco District Sales Office WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF RECEIPT OF MATERIAL to insure approval for return without charge. When we are not advised within 30 days, we will endeavor to authorize return, subject to a handling penalty of 10%.
- 4. Material for which return is requested for any other reason is subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Specific approval must be received—IN WRITING —prior to return, from the Ansco District Office serving the account.
 - b. Material authorized for return must be shipped transportation charges fully prepaid to the specified destination and will be subject to a 10% handling charge.

TRANSPORTATION POLICY-

FREE TRANSPORTATION

Transportation charges will be free on all orders for Ansco photographic merchandise that:

- 1. Total \$200.00 or more at net billing prices.
- Include only items mentioned in this (or subsequent) net price lists.
- 3. Call for one shipment to one destination.
- Consist of advertising materials shown on pages 19 and 20.

EXCEPTIONS: Advertising materials such as photofinishing envelopes, snapfolios, etc., are not subject to free transportation. Orders calling for items not included in this net price list may qualify for free transportation if by themselves they amount to the \$200.00 minimum. Similarly, orders calling for more than one shipping date, or more than one destination, may qualify if each shipment amounts to the \$200.00 minimum.

BACKORDERS: All backorders will be shipped with transportation paid to destination.

METHOD OF SHIPMENT: Qualifying orders will be shipped by carrier selected by Ansco. If more expensive routing is requested, customer will pay the difference in transportation cost.

CLAIMS FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE IN TRANSIT: Normally the dealer is responsible for filing all claims (other than Parcel Post). When necessary, ANSCO will assist the dealer *if all* required documents are provided.

- If a shipment is received short or damaged, this should be noted on all copies of the receipt and the dealer should file claim accordingly.
- If the loss or damage is concealed, the dealer must report this to the delivering carrier within 15 days, for inspection, prior to filing a claim.
- Loss or damage in Parcel Post shipments should be brought to the attention of ANSCO, point of shipment, for instructions.
- 4. We recommend that any shipment returned to ANSCO should be insured against loss and damage.

On orders of \$1200.00 net, or more, we will allow a special quantity discount of 5% if ordered in unbroken carton quantities for shipment at one time.

CONTRAST GRADES of the various papers are indicated by numbers, and colors as follows:

No. 0—For extremely contrasty negatives	Silver
No. 1—For contrasty negatives	Red
No. 2—For average negatives	Green
No. 3—For slightly flat negatives	Magenta
No. 4—For very flat negatives	Blue

SURFACE TYPES are indicated by letters and names as follows:

B-Brilliant. Finely stippled surface with high sheen (natural white).

- C-Cyltex. Rough surface with slight sheen (natural white)
- GL-Glossy. Smooth surface with high sheen (white)
- K—Kashmir. Pebbled surface with slight sheen (natural white). Particularly recommended for oil coloring.
- S-Satex. Smooth surface with slight sheen (natural white)
- V—Velvet. Smooth, semi-matte surface (white)
- Y-Silk-like texture with high sheen (natural white)





Where repairs are not covered by Ansco Warranty, they will be made at the prices listed. In the event repairs are of both warranty and nonwarranty nature, charges will be made only on the non-warranty repairs.

Cameras repaired due to customer mishandling will be billed to the sender, in accordance with these prices as established by Ansco.

*SPECIAL CADET GUARANTEE POLICY

Ansco Cadet, Cadet Reflex and Cadet Flash cameras are unconditionally guaranteed for one year when the camera has been registered with Ansco. This guarantee covers any camera failure, including accidental damage. There is a 50c fee to cover postage and handling. (If manufacturing defect appears within first 90 days after purchase, the handling charge is waived.) Defective Cadet cameras covered by this guarantee should be returned to the Ansco district office in which the camera was registered and a replacement camera will be sent by return mail.

EXPLANATION OF REPAIR LISTINGS

KEY REPAIRS-Repair or replacement.

BODY REPAIRS—Repair and adjust all parts of camera, except shutter and bellows—new parts and minor cover repairs included. Complete re-covering will be quoted separately.

SHUTTER REPAIRS—Repair, adjust and time shutter, including new parts damaged.

SHUTTER REPLACEMENT—Synchro-Compur and other precision shutters are susceptible to internal damage from undue pressure or a blow or bump against the lens and shutter. This may cause irreparable damage within the shutter. Even though such damage may not be sufficient to be seen from the outside, the optical alignment of the lenses may also be disturbed. In such an event, a new lens and shutter must be installed.

NEW BELLOWS - Complete new bellows installed.

REFOCUS—Where it is necessary because of mishandling, wear, or addition of supplemental devices not installed by Ansco.

FILM TRANSPORT-Repair and adjust.

GENERAL OVERHAUL—Repair, adjust and check body, shutter, lens and bellows; furnish new parts, including bellows if necessary.

RANGEFINDER-Repair of focusing mechanisms and adjustment of optics.

Occasionally, cameras are damaged to such an extent that repairing is impractical. In such cases, special prices quoted for general overhaul will not apply.

FLASH EQUIPMENT—Failure of a flash unit to work may not necessarily be the fault of the flash unit itself. It may be caused by worn out batteries or the use of improper flashlamps. Consult the instruction folder for the recommended flashlamps. Test the unit with fresh batteries and the correct lamp. If it still fails to work properly, it is advisable to send both the camera and flash unit for repair.

NOTE: For cameras and repairs not listed, repairs will be made on an estimate basis only. Send camera packed as instructed and we will advise you the cost of repairs. Camera will be held awaiting your approval of the estimated cost, or your request to return the camera without repair.

DO NOT SEND any accessories such as carrying cases, lens attachments, neck cords, instruction books, etc. Responsibility for return of such items will not be accepted.

IMPORTANT PACKING INSTRUCTIONS

- Carefully inspect camera to be repaired to determine what parts are broken, worn or need adjustment.
- Check repairs required against price list and tell customer approximately how much the repairs will cost.
- In your instructions sent with camera for repair, be specific and if only certain repairs are desired, indicate that repairs are to be limited to those requested, only.
- 4. If there is any doubt about the cost of the repairs required, request an estimate of the total cost and that repairs be held up until the estimate is approved.
- To avoid further damage in transit, PACK THE CAMERA CAREFULLY and insure the package.
- 6. Ship according to the following instructions: If package is sent by parcel post, you may enclose written instructions, but you *must* write on the outside of the package "First Class Mail Enclosed." Place the required parcel post stamps and a 4c stamp for the letter on the package. This method will bring your package and instructions to us at the same time and facilitate service.
