

KODACHROME FILM AND PRINTS



KODACHROME FILM for miniature cameras is made in two forms— Daylight Type for outdoor use and Type A for use with artificial light. The following table supplies the details:

KODACHROME PROFESSIONAL FILM is available in a variety of sheet sizes for use in cameras that accept sheet film holders.

After you have taken your color pictures, send the exposed film to Kodak for processing. The charge for processing is included in the original price of your film. Your pictures on miniature Kodachrome Film will be returned to you individually mounted as full-color transparencies in 2 x 2-inch pressboard mounts, ready for projection. Kodachrome Professional Film transparencies are returned in Kodapak Sleeves.

KODACHROME PRINTS are full-color enlargements made from your original 35mm. $(24 \times 36 \text{mm.})$ or Bantam $(28 \times 40 \text{mm.})$ transparencies. They can be ordered only through your dealer. If you should want Kodachrome Prints made at the time your Kodachrome Film is processed, take the film to your dealer and ask him to send it to Rochester with a process and print order. On such orders, Kodak will print only those transparencies which, in their opinion, will yield prints that will be satisfactory to you. When you are selecting

transparencies from which Kodachrome Prints will be made, check carefully for accurate color rendering, sharp definition, correct exposure, and low contrast.

Kodachrome Prints are made in four standard sizes from original Kodachrome transparencies. These standard sizes of Kodachrome Prints utilize the full, uncropped picture area of the transparency. The 2X and 3X sizes are furnished unmounted and printed without margins. The 5X and 8X sizes are delivered in handsome oversize double mounts. The sizes and prices of standard Kodachrome Prints are as follows:

SPECIAL SIZES When Kodachrome Prints are to be framed, special sizes are often desirable, such as $4 \ge 5$ inches, $6 \ge 8$ inches, $6 \ge 9$ inches, etc. These can be ordered in any size up to $11 \ge 14$ inches from either the full picture area of the transparency or any designated portion. The prices are as follows:

KODACHROME DUPLICATES Your miniature Kodachrome transparencies can be duplicated in their present size or enlarged as much as six times the original size. Place your order through your dealer.

BLACK-AND-WHITE PRINTS for record purposes can be made from your Kodachrome transparencies. These can be obtained by making either contact or enlarged black-and-white negatives from the transparencies, using Kodak Panatomic-X Film. From these negatives, prints or enlargements are made in the usual way. **THE KODAK DYE TRANSFER PROCESS** offers the advanced amateur an opportunity to make his own color prints from Kodachrome transparencies. Information concerning this process is available from your Kodak dealer or from the Sales Service Division, Eastman Kodak Company, Rochester 4, N. Y.

FILTERS are not ordinarily required with Kodachrome Film, but their use in some instances is helpful. Four filters are provided:

Kodachrome Haze Filter successfully reduces the bluish haze in distant landscapes.

Kodachrome Type A Filter adapts Type A Kodachrome Film for daylight exposures.

Kodachrome Type B Filter permits the use of Type B Professional Kodachrome Film outdoors.

Kodachrome Filter for Photoflood makes it possible to use Daylight Type Kodachrome Film indoors with Photofloods.

KODAK POLA-SCREEN In color photography, a polarizing filter such as the Kodak Pola-Screen offers the only means of darkening a blue sky without altering other color values in the scene. It will also subdue reflections from glass, wood, water, and other nonmetallic surfaces.

COLOR DATA BOOK on Kodachrome and Kodacolor Film provides a wealth of authoritative information that will be helpful to either the amateur or the professional interested in color photography.

KODAGUIDES point the way to accurate exposures. When using Kodachrome Film outdoors or with Photofloods refer to the Snapshot Kodaguide—and, for flash pictures, use the Flash Kodaguide. Each guide—20 cents.




KODASLIDE PROJECTOR, MODEL 2A


COMBINATION CASE


