The classical $2^{1/4} \times 2^{1/4}$ " size, the "format without limitations" for giant-size color projection and extreme enlargements in blackand-white and color. Two models available:

ROLLEIFLEX 3.5 with Zeiss Planar or Schneider Xenotar f:3.5/75 mm – the universal camera for the discriminating amateur and the preferred equipment for the photo-reporter.

ROLLEIFLEX 2.8 E with Zeiss Planar or Schneider Xenotar f:2.8/80 mm — the King of the Rollei Family, the super model with high speed lens for professional, scientific and technical purposes.

Light meter with direct readings in LVS numbers (built into the focusing knob). Dual-range measuring system guarantees highest accuracy. Readings can be checked conveniently with camera in shooting position. Attachable incident light diffusor.

Viewer: Finest grain, polished, squared ground glass screen, with upright viewing image identical to that of finished picture. Automatic parallax compensation.

Focusing (2.5 times) magnifier covering entire picture area. Built-in direct open sports finder with 4 times focusing magnifier located just below, for eye-level pictures. Large, easy to handle focusing knob. Automatic depth-of-field indicator, coupled to diaphragm. Reminder dial for film type.

Synchro-Compur shutter, fully synchronized for all types of flash (M-X contact). Self-timer. LVS settings secured with locking button, which can be disengaged at will. Handy control wheels and common peep window for speed and diaphragm settings. Click-stop shutter speeds $^{1}/_{500}$ th - 1 sec. and B (time exposures). Body release with safety lock.

Automatic shutter cocking coupled to film transport. Feeler mechanism stops film automatically in correct position for first exposure. Crank for rapid film advance. Built-in protection against double exposures or blank frames; however, intentional multiple exposures are also possible. Two-format back with adjustable film pressure plate for 12 $2^{1/4}$ x $2^{1/4}$ " exposures on 120 (B II 8) film or — when using Rolleikin — for 20 or 36 exposures 24 x 36 mm on 35 mm film.

The ground glass screen of the twin lens reflex camera offers a **constantly** visible image. The popular Five-Format-Camera for the amateur. Truly versatile in performance, adapting in number and size of pictures to your various needs. Film savings from 25 to 50 %, as the interchangeable counter dials permit switching from the normal 12-picture operation to 16 or even 24 frames on the same length of film. Two screen filling formats for color projection $2^{1/4} \times 2^{1/4}$ " and $1^{5/8} \times 1^{5/8}$ " (slide mounts $2^{1/2} \times 2^{1/2}$ " and 2×2 ") and three economy formats down to 24×36 mm ($1 \times 1^{1/2}$ ").

Viewer: Folding focusing hood, convertible into direct open sports finder, after focusing. Focusing magnifier (2.5 times). Automatic parallax compensation. Depth-of-field indicator. Film speed reminder DIN/ASA.

Synchro-Compur-MXV shutter with locking light value settings and self-timer. Click stop speed settings $^{1}/_{500}$ th - 1 sec. and B. Cross-coupled speed and diaphragm controls, can also be operated separately. Single-operation lever cocks and releases shutter. Body release. Double exposure prevention lock, can be disengaged at will for intentional multiple exposures.

Film transport – Large, handy film transport knob. Automatic stop. Starting film by means of starting marks while back is still open. Interchangeable film counter dials for converting to 16 or 24 frame operation (before loading camera with 120 film). Detachable camera back, with LVS table.

Rolleiflex 4×4

The small camera with the logical format, the light and elegant Rollei for sports und travel. In spite of its size, this camera makes a large $1^5/s \times 1^5/s''$ Super-Slide which fits the miniature slide projector—it is the largest size possible with $2 \times 2''$ slide mounts, which are never used to full advantage with the conventional miniature horizontal or vertical pictures. Unquestionably, the Super-Slide gives the largest projection pictures and is also a most convenient format for negative work and for brilliant color enlargements in giant sizes.

Viewer: Flat folding focusing hood. Built-in direct viewfinder. Exceptionally bright image on the ruled field-lens type ground glass screen. 4.5 times focusing magnifier. Convenient focusing knob, with depth-offield indicator.

Synchro-Compur-MXV shutter with secured light value settings and self-timer. Large speed control ring with click stop settings from $^{1}/_{500}$ th -1 sec. and B. Self-locking diaphragm lever permits convenient one-grip operation of speed-diaphragm controls. Functionally placed body release, locked when hood is closed.
