

There is just one adjustment in their operation, and even that is necessary only if you want to change from snapshots to time exposures, or vice versa. Verticals or horizontals... these cameras make them with equal ease... and it matters not whether the user is youngster or grown-up.






VEN a full-color illustration can't do justice to the Rainbow Vest Pocket Hawk-Eye ... You'll have to see and handle it in order to appreciate its dainty beauty. The key colors, carried out in shimmering damaskene lacquers, are orchid (illustrated), marsh green, rose and steel blue. Harmonizing with them are delicate tints on shutter, bellows and bed. Add gleaming nickel fittings and a gold or silver sheen on the body, and you have as brilliant yet tasteful a color ensemble as has ever been offered in a camera.

The black camera is covered with imitation leather, and comes with either a single or a double lens. Both black and colored models make clear snapshots or time exposures, 15% x 2½ inches.

Vest Pocket Hawk-Eye in Rainbow colors, single lens, \$6.00. In black, with single lens, \$5.00; with double lens, \$7.50.










No. 3A (3¼ x 5½ inches), single lens, black, \$13.50; double lens, black, \$16.00.




