

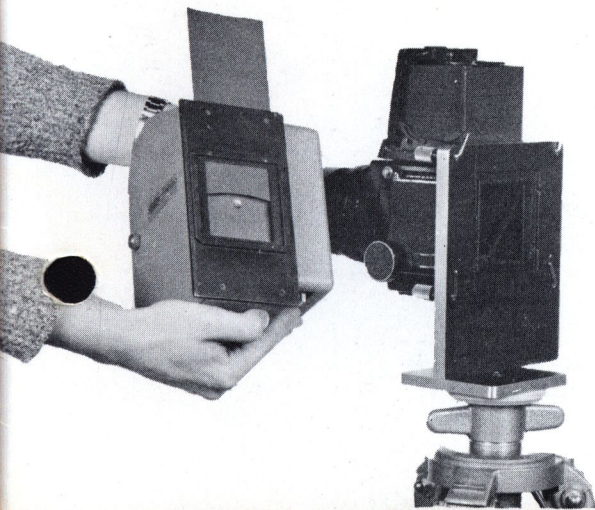


# MOTOR DRIVE MAGAZINES FOR RB-67

## HAWK 67BC Adapter

A precision aluminum mount. A machined light trap on the face matches the normal mount of an RB-67 camera. A special matching light seal on the back interfaces with modified Coleman film magazines. Both magazine and camera are balanced for easy handling. The 67BC Adapter prevents excess weight on the camera back locking mechanism.



## Advantages of HAWK 67BC Adapter

Automatic film advance. Film advances one frame on cocking of camera shutter. Built-in frame counter keeps track of exposures.

Magazines mount in horizontal or vertical position.

Can be used with either direct or reflex view finders on RB-67.

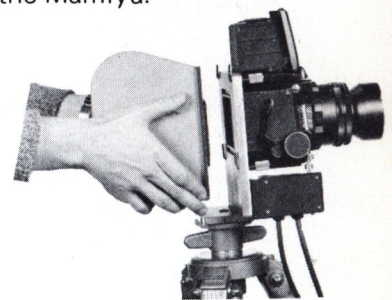
Machined light traps duplicate the original camera design for great reliability in outdoor photography.

Uses highly reliable and proven Coleman magazines modified for correct film placement and spacing on the Mamiya.

Long roll allows you to take advantage of lower processing and printing costs.



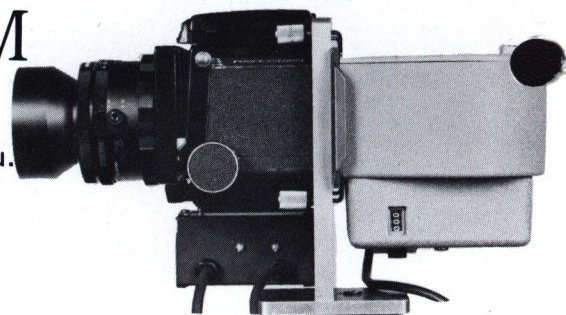
If you own a Mamiya RB-67 camera, you now can enjoy the advantages of long roll film.

**NOTE:** You can run your HAWK back plus one 1200 w/s Balcar flash (on slow charge) from a DA12 Generator. This compact device operates from an auto 12 volt battery at 120 volts, 5 amperes. You can do volume environmental photography on long roll by using an extension line from your car battery! The DA12 generator will run both the flash and your motor drive back.
