FILM GUIDE

Professional quality, black and white prints and negatives. Polaroid Type 665 Land film provides both without a darkroom. Negatives are of a high quality with medium contrast. Negative image resolution is in excess of 150 lines/mm. Recommended exposure meter setting: 75 ASA, 19 DIN.

High speed black and white prints. Polaroid Types 87, 107 and 667 Land films are the most sensitive black and panchromatic film emulsion made for general purpose photographic and scientific recording. Recommended exposure setting: 3000 ASA, 36 DIN.

Full color prints. Polaroid Polacolor 2 and Polacolor Types 108, 88 and 668 Land films produce fully processed color prints in 60 seconds. Colors are rich, saturated, and show good detail in shadow areas. Daylight color balanced. Prints from Polacolor 2 are more saturated and fade resistant. Recommended exposure meter setting: 57 ASA, 19 DIN.
