PREMO JUNIOR CAMERAS



I NEXPENSIVE but well made, and reliable in every respect, these simple cameras are capable of producing very good pictures in all ordinary work, such as portraiture, snap shots in good light, average land-scapes, and the like.

They are all fitted with tested lenses and automatic shutters. They are substantially made to withstand hard knocks, covered with imitation leather and are neat and attractive in appearance.

To make a picture with a Premo Jr. is a matter of seconds only. No focusing, no estimating of distances, is necessary.

To load, open the back in any

light, drop in Premo Film Pack and close the back.

Then set the shutter for time or instantaneous exposure as required by the conditions of light. This is accomplished by merely moving a lever up or down.

Now glance at the finder, compose the picture, press a lever and the exposure is made.

Good enough to satisfy the many grown-up amateurs who are using them, these are really ideal cameras for boys and girls, by reason of their low cost, substantial construction and simple operation.



POCKET PREMO C



THERE are many amateurs who, for certain kinds of work, insist upon the ground glass for absolutely sharp focusing and for composition. The Pocket Premo C offers this advantage in addition to the daylight loading feature, the compactness and the other conveniences of the average film camera.

The Pocket Premo C takes films or plates with equal facility, the ground glass may be used equally well for focusing, no matter which is being used, or, if preferred, the subject may be located and focused by means of the finder and focusing scale, just as with the ordinary film camera. In other words, the ground

glass is just an added feature—one that need not be used unless the necessity arises, and then it is there.

There are no complications whatever in this camera. Plates are loaded in an ordinary double plate holder or films in the Premo Film Pack Adapter, which goes into the camera just as the holder does. A rack and pinion is supplied for fine focusing, and the camera is carefully constructed in every detail.

As in all Premos, particular attention is paid to the lens and shutter equipment. The latest type of ball bearing shutter with cable release is supplied, and the lens is the Planatograph—the best grade of R. R. lens

that can be manufactured.

Like the Pocket Premo C, this model offers the ground glass focusing feature in connection with the use of either films or plates, as the owner may desire. But it has even greater capabilities, having a number of added equipments providing for a wider range of work.

The shutter fitted to this model is the Kodak Automatic with Kodak Autotime Scale. This shutter is graduated for fractional parts of a second from 1 to 1/100, and the Autotime Scale indicates at a glance just the correct exposure for all outdoor subjects under all conditions. The camera is fitted with rising and sliding front and swing bed for decreasing



A S an inexpensive, reliable plate camera, the Premo No. 8 would be a most attractive proposition to any amateur photographer who desires the advantage of ground glass focusing. But it is more than a plate camera. By means of the Premo Film Pack Adapter it may be instantly converted into a daylight loading film camera and still retain the advantage of ground glass focusing. So that this one camera really does the work of two.

The Premo No. 8 is made of seasoned wood, with front bed of aluminum and metal runways, making an instrument of unusual compactness for a plate camera. The bed and box are covered with black leather, the bellows is black and the metal parts

being finished in nickel, give the camera a very neat, attractive appearance.

The standard is made of metal and is very rigid, a rising and falling front is supplied, and the finder is of the new Premo collapsible type.

The shutter is the Kodak Ball Bearing with bulb and tube release, in which is fitted our regular tested Planatograph lens, an equipment amply efficient for general amateur work.

In this model all our manufacturing experience has been put into the proposition of providing a camera of very wide latitude, as compact in form as such a camera can possibly be made, and to sell at a moderate price.

Although folding up into an unusually thin body, the bellows is of sufficient length to permit the use of the single lens combination or a telephoto attachment of several magnifications. The extension bed is actuated with rack and pinion, working with exceptional smoothness and provided with a simple locking device.

The standard is constructed of metal, it is very rigid, and incorporates a rising and falling front of great latitude. This in connection with the swing bed construction makes it an easy matter to take pictures of tall buildings, and the like, without tipping the camera, with its attendant distortion. The lens board is removable, the finder is the new Premo collapsible brilliant, and the back is reversible.





EASTMAN PLATE TANK

THIS produces the same good results as does the Premo Film Pack Tank, and consists of a metal solution cup with tightly fitting cover, a cage for holding twelve plates or less, and



a loading fixture for loading the plates into the cage. It is very simple to use and requires but a few moments in the dark room to load.

When extended each section catches and holds firmly. To close, it is necessary to press in top catch only.

The Nos. 1 and 2 have revolving heads for attaching to camera. With this construction the camera may be swung, so as to take in the desired view without moving the tripod.

The Nos. 1 and 2 also have straps for holding the legs in place when closed.
