
## Graflex xl Flash Bracket Guidebook





This new bracket is designed expressly for Graflex xI cameras. It features a convenient Captive xI Flash Bracket Cord for easier and more reliable flash attachment. And it holds all flash equipment utilizing Graflite<sup>®</sup> Heavy Duty Mounting Clamps.

## Attaching xl Flash Bracket to Camera

**1.** Align the two rigid-mounting posts with the corresponding threaded holes in the side of your xl camera (Fig. 1).

**2.** With a standard screwdriver, thread the bracket retaining screws into the threaded holes in the side of the camera. Tighten firmly (Fig. 1).





## **Connecting Sync Shutter Cord**

1. Connect ASA Bi-post Sync Shutter Cord exactly as shown, to obtain proper polarity. Bring the Bi-post Cord forward from the fitting on the Captive xI Flash Bracket cord and downward from the Shutter Outlet on the flash unit (Fig. 2). If constant cycling of electronic flash occurs, reverse the connection of the Bi-post Cord to Captive xI Flash Bracket Cord.

**2.** Connect free end of Captive xI Flash Bracket Cord to flash connection on Shutter (Fig. 2).
