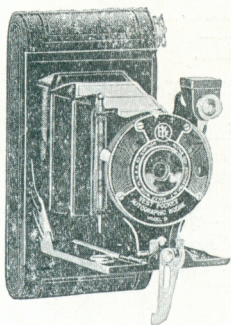

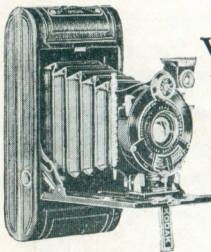
This compact and dainty little Kodak is a well-equipped and efficient picture-maker. It is superior to the Model B in finish, and equipment, but makes pictures of the same size— $2\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{5}{8}$ inches; sharp pictures that will stand a considerable degree of enlargement. There is a choice of two lenses and shutters—the “Kodar” f.7.9 in “Kodex” shutter and “Kodak” Anastigmat f.6.3 in “Diomatic” shutter. Focussing is adjustable, with scales. Finder, reversible brilliant. Two tripod sockets. Autographic feature.

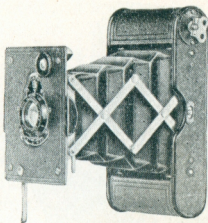

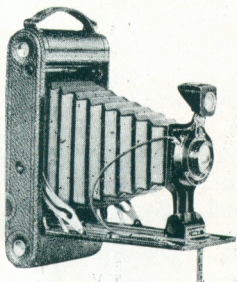

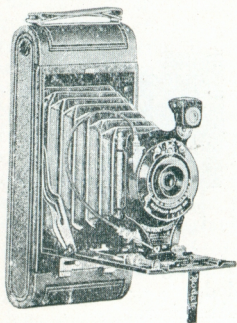

These new model Kodaks are sturdily built to withstand real hard wear, yet are compactly made and daintily finished. Either of them, folded, will carry comfortably in the pocket.

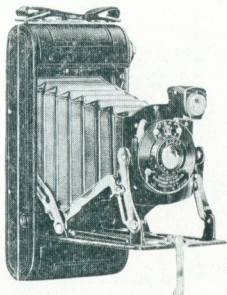
Special Features.

Bodies are of stiff metal, covered with real leather of neat appearance and splendid durability. Fittings nickel and black enamel. Focus is adjusted with a worm screw, convenient for the thumb.

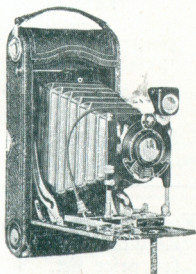

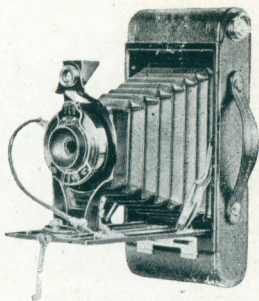

Kodascope C projector, price £17, is electrically driven by the house lighting circuit. A “stop” feature permits halting the picture for a longer look at any incident.

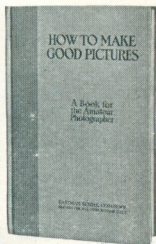
