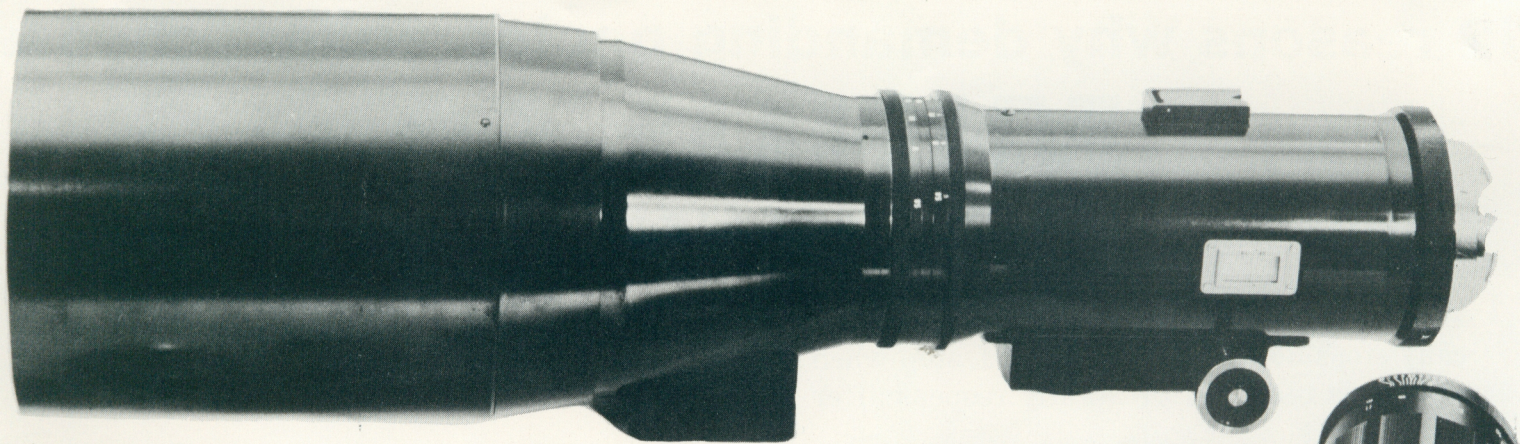

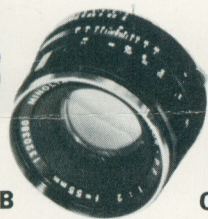

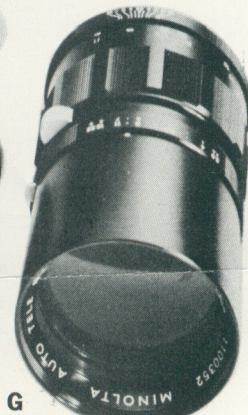

A Auto Rokkor 35 mm, f:2.8, 7 elements, 64° angle view, focuses from 12 inches to infinity, automatic diaphragm—\$119.50.

D Auto Tele Rokkor 100 mm, f:3.5, 5 elements, 24° angle view, focuses 47 inches to infinity, automatic diaphragm—\$99.50.

(Not shown) Rokkor 35 mm, f:4, 5 elements, 64° angle of view, focuses 15.8 in. to infinity, pre-set diaphragm—\$59.50.

(Not shown) Auto Tele Rokkor 100mm, f/2, 6 elements, 24° angle of view, focuses 47 inches to infinity, automatic diaphragm—\$169.50.

(Not shown) Macro Rokkor 50 mm, f/3.5, 5 elements, 45° angle of view, focuses 4 inches to infinity without bellows, corrected for Macro work, aperture ring compensates for extension—\$99.50.

E Tele Rokkor 135mm, f/4, 3 elements, 18° angle, focuses 59 inches to infinity, pre-set diaphragm—\$69.50.

(Not shown) Tele Rokkor TC 135mm, f/4 lens head fits on bellows unit, 18° angle of view, focuses for reproduction ratio of 1:1, as well as infinity, pre-set diaphragm—\$45.00.

B Standard 58mm, f/1.4 lens provided with SR-3, 55mm, f/1.8 lens provided with SR-1. 41° and 43° angles respectively. Lenses have fully automatic diaphragms, depth-of-field preview, and double coating to eliminate need for UV Filter.

F Auto Tele Rokkor 135 mm, f:2.8, 7 elements, 18° angle view, focuses 59 inches to infinity, automatic diaphragm—\$139.50.

C Tele Rokkor 100mm, f/4, 3 elements, 24° angle, focuses 47 inches to infinity, pre-set diaphragm—\$59.50.

G Auto Tele Rokkor 200 mm, f:3.5, 6 elements, 12° angle view, focuses 79 inches to infinity, semi-automatic diaphragm—\$179.50.
