
This camera, while designed primarily for the photographing of rapidly moving objects, is equally well adapted to all other classes of work.

The important feature is the Kodak Focal Plane shutter, by means of which automatic exposures, varying from $\frac{1}{6}$ of a second up to $\frac{1}{1000}$ of a second, may be made. It is also, of course, adapted to time exposures.

The shutter is in no way complicated, and is simple to understand and operate.

Equipped with this type of shutter, the 4A Speed Kodak is ideal for photographing all objects in rapid motion—such as athletes, race horses, automobiles—and is also well adapted to home portraiture. When closed, the camera is very compact—less than half the size of other cameras containing a focal plane shutter.

BROWNIE DEVELOPING BOX

The Brownie Developing Box is a simplification of the Kodak Tank, such simplification being made possible by the short length of the No. 1 and No. 2 Brownie film.

The No. 2 Brownie Developing Box is a metal box fifteen inches in length, just long enough to accommodate a roll of No. 1 or No. 2 Brownie film in one loop. To develop, the roll of film is inserted in the spool carrier and by means of a cord and winding shaft the film is unrolled and carried around a roller bearing, thus exposing the entire surface to the action of the developer.

When the film is developed the developer is poured off and the box filled with water to thoroughly wash out the developer. The film may then be removed in daylight to the fixing bath.



THE KODAK FILM TANK.

The tank development of film does away with the dark room. By simple methods it gives quality that was unattainable by the old methods.

To develop in the tank the film is simply wound on the transferring reel in a light tight box, a process as simple as loading the Kodak; transferred in daylight to the cup containing the developing solution; left for ten or twenty minutes, according to the strength of developer, rinsed and removed in daylight to the tray of fixing solution.

It is entirely self-contained, all parts packing easily within the transferring box when not in use.
