
Specially suitable for quick "snap shot" work, it is only necessary to pull out the front to its full extent and the Vest Pocket Kodak is in focus for objects at any distance.


Upon pressing a button the bed drops and the lens and shutter spring automatically into position—ready at once for making pictures of objects at any distance.







Six-Three Kodaks


THE Six-Three Kodaks, introduced early in the year, have scored a splendid success. Having all the Kodak simplicity, they provide those who want the full anastigmat advantages of definition, flatness of field, and speed, at the minimum of expense, with suitably equipped and perfectly reliable cameras.

Starting with the regular Kodak models, in the standard sizes, as a basis, we have simply replaced the Rapid Rectilinear lens and Ball Bearing shutter with the Compound shutter and the new Cooke Kodak Anastigmat lens.

The lens has been specially designed for this particular use by the makers of the well-known Cooke Anastigmat Lenses. It is an anastigmat of the very first quality, fully corrected for definition and flatness of field, and working at a speed of f. 6.3. The shutter is the Compound, but operated with antinous release instead of bulb and tube.

As the models are alike in every other respect, for details on any Six-Three Kodak it is necessary to merely refer to the detailed specifications of the regular models.



It consists of a metal box, with cover, just long enough to accommodate a roll of No. 1 or No. 2 Brownie film in one loop. To develop, the roll of film is inserted in the spool carrier, and by means of a cord and winding shaft the film is unrolled and carried around a roller bearing thus exposing the film to the action of the developer. The box is then rocked on its standard for six minutes, the developer poured off, film washed and removed for fixing.
