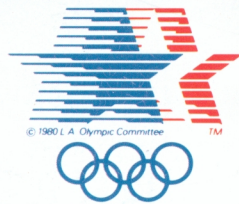
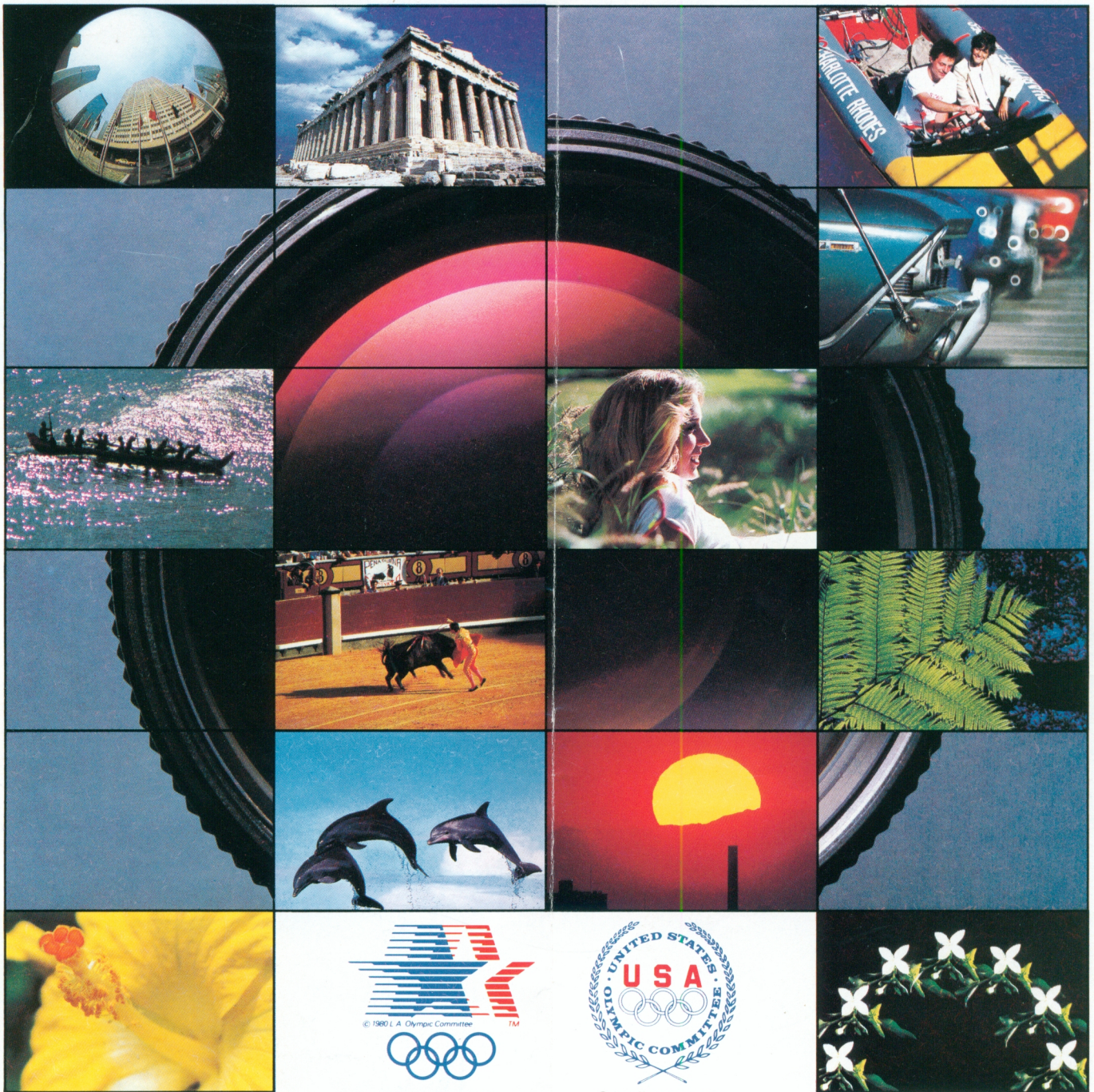

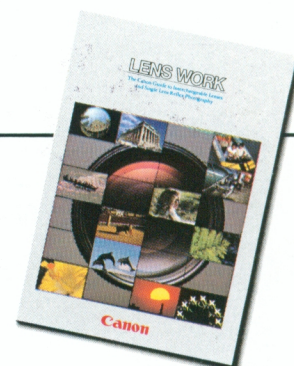

With a standard 50mm lens, you often can't get the entire area of a subject in the picture (below). Adding a wide-angle lens, such as one of our popular 28mm lenses, gives you more than enough room (right). They're great for enclosed areas too.

Great for scenic and indoor shots, Canon FD wide-angle lenses provide wider angles of view and greater depth of field (which means more area in focus). For creative composition, the unique perspective expands apparent foreground and background distances.

When you want to capture the intimate beauty of objects such as flowers, the conventional 50mm lens' minimum focusing distance usually just isn't enough (below). But a macro lens can focus much closer for that added dimension (right). And you can use them for conventional photography too.

When you want to photograph small objects, Canon FD Macro lenses are the answer. Depending on the lens you select, they provide magnification ratios of up to life size right on the film. And you can get even higher magnifications with additional Canon FD extension tubes and bellows.

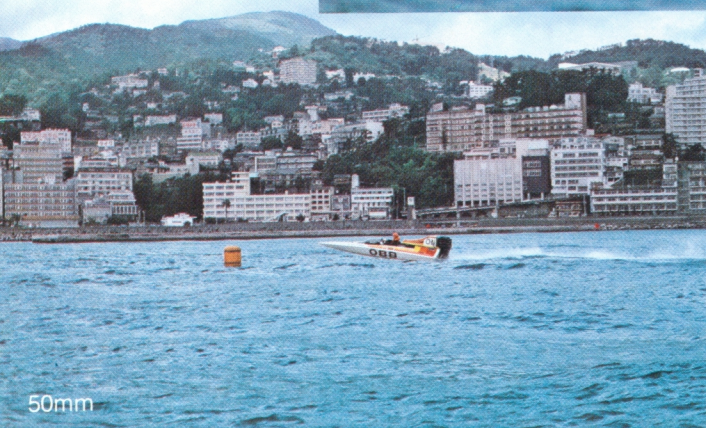

Often, you can't get close enough to your subject with a 50mm lens (below). But a telephoto lens, such as a 200mm lens, gives you that extra "reach" (right). Telephoto lenses will give you many times the magnification of normal lenses.

Canon FD telephoto lenses enable you to "reach out" to faraway subjects. Different telephoto lenses give you ideal focal lengths for portrait, candid, nature, sports and action photography. For creative composition, the lens perspective compresses apparent foreground and background distances.
