On Winter Photography

A LL Kodak film is now speed film—and that means a decided advantage in the short winter days. It doesn't mean that you can make snap-shots indoors or even outof-doors when the clouds are heavy-but it does mean better pictures under average winter conditions

When we began the manufacture of "Speed" film it was decidedly faster than our regular N. C. emulsion. There were, however, some particulars, such as uniformity and keeping quality, in which it was more difficult to control than the old reliable "N. C." In order to protect our customers against film that might have deteriorated through age, we did not give it as long a dating as the N. C. film. We were inclined to make haste slowly.

In the Speed film, we had just what we claimed for it: "speed." In the N. C. film, which had a very different emulsion, we had beautiful gradation and absolute reliability. Gradually, during a period of six years, we have increased the speed of our N. C. film without losing one jot of its reliability, keeping quality or its fineness of gradation.

All Kodak film is now Non-Curling Speed film, both the Autographic, and the film that is wound in the old way without the autographic feature. Both are the reliable, dependable film

-with added speed.

Practically all negative emulsions (both plates and films) and Kodak film in particular. have a wide latitude on the side of over-exposure. This means, that while your pictures will be unsatisfactory if even a little underexposed, they can have considerably more than the necessary exposure without the slightest harm. The moral is, of course, when in doubt take the choice of erring on the side of overexposure. Kodak Speed film will help out appreciably by giving better timed negatives than can be obtained with other films when light conditions are poor. On the other hand, the latitude is such that you can expose and should expose, under good light conditions, just the same as you always have with the regular Kodak N. C. film. It isn't intended that you should cut down exposures when using Speed film. It is intended that you shall get better negatives when working under adverse conditions-and you will.

While this furnishing of a speedier film is a help, at no increased cost to him, to every user of Kodaks and Brownies there is another decided help—the Kodak Anastigmat lens.

The now famous Kodak Anastigmat lenses, on account of their high quality and low cost—started the movement for a wide use of better lenses. They are made for a specific purpose and fulfill it.

As a rule, Anastigmat lenses are made to serve a dual purpose. The lens that is to cover a 4×5 plate, for example, at its largest open-

ing is intended also for a 5 x 7 plate, as a wide angle lens when used with a small stop. It is, therefore, corrected to hit the "happy medium"

and serve both purposes.

The Kodak Anastigmats have no such handicap. They are corrected to cover only the particular size for which they are listed. No consideration has to be given to anything else, because nothing else is likely to be asked of them.

The result is, the Kodak Anastigmats give the utmost in efficiency for the specific purpose for which they are designed—and we are able to make and sell them at a lower price than the dual purpose lenses.

Improvements such as these have increased the efficiency and maintained the simplicity of the Kodak System of Photography and made it so practical that it can be used at any time.





THE Juniors are compact, reliable cameras of high efficiency, easy to operate and so thin as to be pocketed without inconvenience.




The camera has the same thin, compact form and reliable equipment as have the Nos. 1 and 1A Juniors, though the 2C is supplied only as a focusing camera.
