
Made to be always ready for action, it is only necessary to pull out the front to its full extent and the Vest Pocket Kodak is in focus for objects at any distance.

Starting with the regular Kodak models, in the standard sizes, as a basis, we have simply replaced the Rapid Rectilinear lens and Ball Bearing shutter with the Compound shutter and the new Cooke Kodak Anastigmat lens.

This lens has been specially designed for this particular use by the makers of the well-known Cooke Anastigmat Lenses. It is an anastigmat of the very first quality, fully corrected for definition and flatness of field, and working at a speed of f. 6.3. The shutter is the regular Compound, but operated with antinous release instead of bulb and tube.

The models are alike in every other respect so for details on any Six-Three Kodak it is necessary to merely refer to the detailed specifications of the regular models.


