








Whether it is as small as a cable release, or as intricate as a lens or camera, every piece of Bolex equipment is made with painstaking attention to detail and perfect operation. Bolex production is never hurried. It takes many months to make a single camera, and the Swiss craftsmen at the Bolex factories take the greatest pride in their work.

All new features introduced in Bolex equipment are proved by exhaustive laboratory tests and analyses before production. That is why, although new features are offered from time to time, Bolex cameras and accessories never become obsolete. When Bolex has it, you know it is ready for you.

The light measuring system used in Bolex "Compumatic" cameras is the result of many years of planning and experimentation. In searching for a way to measure exposure with *perfect accuracy*, Paillard engineers located the Bolex "electric eye" *behind* the taking lens opening. This unique positioning allows the Compumatic eye to measure *only* the light that passes through the lens . . . *only* the amount of light that hits the film. The result is absolutely perfect exposures for any kind of lens you use: wide angle, normal, telephoto, or zoom. No other camera can do it! The Compumatic system prevents both dark underexposures and washed out overexposures.



Ordinary "eye" camera responds to all light in front of you. Bright off-scene light fools camera into underexposing your film. Results: heavy, murky colors, lost details.



*Compumatic measures light **through the lens**—sees only exact scene you shoot. Result: perfect exposures every time, with the world's most lifelike color and detail.*





Zoom type viewfinder shows fields of view for different lenses. Supplied with de luxe leather wriststrap and viewfinder attachment for 5.5mm extreme wide angle lenses.



B-8L Compumatic

Includes all professional filming features of D-8L model, but equipped with economical twin-lens turret. Supplied with de luxe leather wriststrap only.

Viewfinder shows field for different lenses; Compumatic "eye" gives you perfect exposures with any lens used. Governor-controlled motor runs at standard 18 frames per second for life-like motion.




Zoom Compumatic

Extra long handle provides greater control over zoom and "dolly" shots . . . makes them


professionally smooth. Compumatic system gives exact exposure for any point in zoom.

Bolex H-8 cameras are designed for 8mm enthusiasts who want the full range of professional features usually found only on 16mm equipment. They are available in two models: the H-8T and the H-8 De Luxe.




Feature for feature, Bolex H-8 models are the *most complete 8mm cameras in the world*, and include every important professional device used on the famous Bolex 16mm line:

- 100 foot film capacity for 200 feet of finished 8mm film
- governor-controlled motor winds easily with telescopic handle
- hand crank permits back winding for lap dissolves and forward winding by hand for unusually long scenes
- speeds from 12 to 64 frames per second for slow motion, speed-ups
- continuous run and single frame settings allow self-filming or animation, special effects
- automatic film threading eliminates costly mistakes
- three lens turret takes any D-mount lens, turns instantly with folding lever
- footage counter shows exact amount of film exposed
- frame counter dials give single and total frame measurements
- H-8T has eye-cup for through-the-lens focusing and "Preview-Finder" with fields of view for 10mm, 12.5mm, 25mm, and 36mm lenses.
- H-8 De Luxe has eye-level focus for ground-glass focusing from behind the lens, and "Octameter" viewfinder with fields of view for 6.5mm, 9mm, 12.5mm, 25mm, 36mm, 50mm, 63mm, and 75mm lenses.
- Both the "Preview-Finder" and the "Octameter" may be fitted with adaptors for 5.5mm extreme wide angle lenses, and have convenient parallax correction devices.

- A dual purpose sound head forms a "third reel" for your projector, through which the film passes both when recording and when showing.
- A high quality directional microphone.
- A loud speaker designed for maximum fidelity and tonal quality.
- An amplifier and control panel which permit "mixing" narrative, sound effects, and music. You record one type of sound at a time, superimposing each, as you progress, over the one previously recorded.




8mm Titler

For close-ups, animation, special effects, titles...the Bolex 8mm Titler makes it easy to give films that "professionally finished" look. The basic titler is equipped with a platform, camera holder, supporting stand, and a unique centering device that *guarantees* perfectly centered titles every time. The centering device is a light which shines directly through the lens onto the titling board to show exactly what will appear on the film. An accessory kit for the 8mm titler includes scroll holder, flap board, drum, disc, and extension legs, to allow a wide variety of titling techniques. Light holders and reflectors are available for perfect lighting control. Titling letters are made for the Bolex 8mm Titler in four colors.

Camera Handle

"Declic" handle permits steady, one-hand support for Bolex "pocket-size" cameras. Attaches to tripod threads on bottom of camera and includes trigger for operation of filming button.




Extension Tubes




Professional Accessories for the **BOLEX H-8**



Titler Precision optical bench for advanced titling techniques and other special effects. Makes titles, animation, extreme close-ups easy.


Basic kit consists of optical bench, main frame, two reflectors, title frame, sliding cradle and rackover. Accessory kit includes multipurpose frame, roller, screen, drum, turntable, mirror frame, animation frame, crank, pivoting plates, three plane support. Complete titler comes with case. Titling letters available in four colors.

Unimotor Electric motor drives camera through 100 foot roll at speeds from 12 to 64 fps. Easily and quickly mounted. Motor can be operated by means of AC current (with Bolex Transformer) or batteries. Can be used for single frame filming, operated by means of either an electrical switch on motor, extension cord, or camera release button. Complete with leather battery case.



Underwater Housing

For underwater movie photography with Bolex H-8 or H-8T at depths down to 330 feet. Camera locked in case by a single lever for easy insertion and removal. Controls permit easy and convenient winding of spring and aperture adjustment. Has full view iconometer with built-in parallax correction to about four feet and sports viewfinder. Case included.



Trigger Handle

A rugged, well-balanced support for filming sporting events and scenes where an orthodox tripod would be inconvenient. Easily attached.



Gunstock A polished wood handle that holds the Bolex H-8 camera. Gives excellent shooting control and camera support. Release trigger in handle couples to camera. Molded to shoulder for eye-level viewing.



H-1 De Luxe Case


